



Garbage and Recycling Toter Policy Effective November 14, 2022

The Mission Trace Board of Directors has approved the following policy with respect to garbage and/or recycle toters left in public view. This policy will become effective on November 14, 2022

Any garbage toter and/or recycling toter left in a location visible from the street following the city of San Antonio pick up day will be moved to the HOA shed, located at the end of Overlake Dr.

<u>TYPE OF TOTER</u>	<u>NORMAL PICK UP DAY (CITY)</u>	<u>MT PICK UP DAY</u>
Brown	Friday	Saturday Morning
Blue & Green	Wednesday	Thursday Morning

If a can is removed, the resident will be responsible for retrieving their toter from the shed. Please retrieve the toter which contains your ID# for your address.

The office receives several calls per week about neighbors who leave the garbage and/or recycling toters out past the pick-up day or even on a permanent basis. Cans should be placed out no earlier than the evening prior to the pick-up day and taken in the evening of the pick-up day. Cans must not be left on driveways or in any other location that is visible from the street.

The Mission Trace Covenants state as follows: Article VII, Section 1(m)

*All garbage will be placed in disposable cans or refuse containers and shall not be placed or permitted to remain at the front of the dwelling either within the street or upon the lot or a Common Area except on those days scheduled for garbage and refuse collection by the City of San Antonio or a privately collected collector...**Except on days for collection as set out above, said containers will be kept in a place that is not subject to public view.***

The procedure is similar to the policy required by San Antonio City Ordinance.
